

**Eligibility and Requirements**

- Applicant must be a resident of (or currently attending school in) Minnesota
- Applicant must have received a high school diploma or GED before the due date of this application. (In other words, the 2025 scholarship is NOT available to current high school students. If interested, please consider applying in a future year)
- Scholarship finalists must be available for an interview
- Scholarship awards will be announced on or before June 30
- Scholarships are awarded without regard to sexual orientation, gender, religious affiliation, or citizenship
- Scholarship recipients are strongly encouraged to attend the Hawkinson Fund award ceremony which will be held mid-October in the Twin Cities
